AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An
 2 act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and
 3 consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of
 4 insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and
 5 protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds
 6 associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and
 7 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and
 8 supervision of insurance carried by such companies,
 9 associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by
 10 the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and
 11 repealing existing laws," in comprehensive health care for
 12 uninsured children, further providing for expiration.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Section 2309-A of the act of May 17, 1921
 16 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921,
 17 added December 20, 2015 (P.L.461, No.84), is amended to read:

18 Section 2309-A. Expiration.

19 (a) General rule.--[This] Subject to subsection (a.1), this
 20 article shall expire on the earlier of:

1 (1) December 31, [2017] 2019; or

2 (2) ninety days after the date on which Federal funding
3 for the program ceases to be available.

4 (a.1) Exception.--If Federal law authorizes funding for the
5 program for a period that extends beyond December 31, 2019, this
6 article shall expire under subsection (a) (2).

7 (b) Notice.--If [the chapter] this article expires under
8 subsection (a) (2), as determined by the department, the
9 department shall transmit notice to the Legislative Reference
10 Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
