



SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

SYNOPSIS:

Amends Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for dog training areas.

SUMMARY:

Amends Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, to lower the required dog training acreage from 100 to 50 acres.

This legislation also permits hunting or trapping of a furbearer or other protected game animal to occur on the dog training acreage during established seasons.

In addition, this legislation limits big game hunting in the dog training areas to those with permission from the permittee, unless the area is conspicuously posted open to the public for big game hunting.

This legislation requires posting of the dog training area.

Effective Date: Effective in 60 days.

BILL HISTORY:

Previously introduced as Senate Bill 1068 of 2013. Voted out of the Senate Game and Fisheries Committee unanimously August 12, 2013. Senate Bill 1068 received third consideration and was unanimously voted out of the Senate (50-0) October 22, 2013. Referred to House Game and Fisheries Committee October 23, 2013, where it did not received any further legislative action.
