SYNOPSIS:

Amends Title 53 to allow the Auditor General to audit municipal authorities.

SUMMARY:

SB 597 provides the Auditor General with the ability to examine and audit the books, accounts, records and performance of any municipal authority in Pennsylvania.

Currently, the Attorney General has the power to examine the books, accounts and records of municipal authorities.

Costs incurred by the Auditor General's review of a municipal authority shall be paid by the authority.
