



## || SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

### Senate Bill 728 Printer's No. 884

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Amends the Achieving Better Care by Monitoring All Prescriptions Program ("ABC-MAP") Act by exempting nonnarcotic Schedule V drugs (used to treat epilepsy) from the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program ("PDMP").

#### **SUMMARY:**

Current law requires a PDMP query for nonnarcotic Schedule V controlled substances. These drugs are specifically indicated to treat epilepsy and seizure disorder and do not contain opioids.

SB 728 adds a Section 8(a.1) (2) to the ABC-MAP Act that exempts nonnarcotic Schedule V controlled substances from the query requirements of the ABC-MAP Act.
