Dear Chairwomen Brown:

I write regarding continuing issues with Sunoco pipeline in Chester County. The latest unilateral decision to repurpose the existing 12" pipeline to transmit NGL is unacceptable. Sunoco's continued disregard of working with local governments and residents is reprehensible.

The location of the 12" pipeline goes directly through residential developments, and is in extremely close proximity to schools and businesses that are located in Uwchlan Township, Chester County.

I request the Public Utility Commission under their authority order a halt to this dangerous situation.


Furthermore, Sunoco should be ordered to meet with both the Chester County and Uwchlan Township Officials to explain the decision and necessity for repurposing this 12" line. Additionally, Sunoco should be ordered to comply with providing all information regarding this decision including:

- Fact finding the decision to repurpose the 12" line
- Age and physical condition of the pipeline
- Safety inspection records of the pipeline
- Alternatives available to Sunoco other than the 12" line
- Chemical make-up of proposed liquids planned for this line
- Emergency plans necessitated by an event with this line

At the very least, Sunoco should be forced to provide this information and be prohibited from using the line for its intended repurposing.
