AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the 5 administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal 7 Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 8 9 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and 10 administrative officers, and of the several administrative 11 departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain 12 13 other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of 15 16 all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; providing for the 17 regulation of pari-mutuel thoroughbred horse racing and 18 harness horse racing activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the disposition of funds from pari-mutuel 19 20 tickets; and prescribing the manner in which the number and 22 compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and 23 employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be determined," in powers and duties in general, providing 24 25 for contact information. 26 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 2 <u>Section 531. Contact Information.--Each department, board</u>
- 3 and commission shall:
- 4 (1) Establish a toll-free telephone number that is staffed
- 5 by an individual during regular business hours and may be used
- 6 to contact the department, board or commission.
- 7 (2) Post the telephone number established under paragraph
- 8 (1) in a clear and conspicuous manner on the publicly accessible
- 9 <u>Internet website of the department, board or commission.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
