#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Designates a bridge on State Route 286 in Montgomery Township, Indiana County, as the Sgt. Edward John Parada Memorial Bridge.

#### **SUMMARY:**

A bridge on State Route 286 is being designated as the Sgt. Edward John Parada Memorial Bridge for the following reasons:

- Sgt. Parada was born and raised in Montgomery Township, Indiana County, and graduated from Purchase Line High School.
- On August 27, 1970, Sgt. Parada was killed in action in Vietnam while serving with the U.S. Army Company E, 327<sup>th</sup> Infantry, 101<sup>st</sup> Airborne Division.

PennDOT shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

Effective Date: 60 days.
