



There have been 8,461 voluntary requests from individuals for placement on the PA Self-Exclusion List.






Self-Exclusion Intake by Year






- Number of self-excluded individuals who reported to have sought treatment prior to self-excluding in PA: 1,653 individuals or 20%
- Number of self-excluded individuals who reported to have self-excluded in other jurisdictions prior to selfexcluding in PA: 511 individuals or 6.1%
- Number of self-excluded individuals who reported to have gambled in PA facilities prior to self-excluding in PA: 4,991 individuals or 59%
- Age range of self-excluded individuals: 21-94 years**

Self-Exclusion Violations

 Self-excluded individuals that have been caught violating self-exclusion have been identified visually or when the selfexcluded individual attempted a transaction that requires proof of identification (obtaining a players club card, obtaining credit, attempting to claim a jackpot, cashing a check or simply being "carded").


Violation Breakdown

Self-Exclusion Removals

- ❖ As of May 31, 2015, there have been 2,253 requests for removal from the Self-Exclusion List.
- Number of removed individuals who have voluntarily requested to be placed back on the Self-Exclusion List: 402 or 18%
- Number of removed individuals who placed themselves back on the Self-Exclusion List and chose a lifetime ban: 79 or 20% of the 402.
- Number of self-excluded individuals whose term has concluded, but have not removed themselves from the Self-Exclusion List: 1,979
- Number of removed individuals who admitted to seeking treatment while on the Self-Exclusion List: 257
- Number of removed individuals who admitted to gambling in Pennsylvania while on the Self-Exclusion List: 192
