- Use the data to change the social perceptions of young people – e.g. "Join the Majority"

Trends found in PAYS

 Students involved in extracurricular activities are less likely to use drugs

• Prescription drug use is on the rise

- Prescription drug use often leads to heroin use
- Need to campaign against prescription drugs

Campaign Efforts

- "Find Your Anti-Drug," and "Join the Majority" Campaigns
 - Grant Funded
 - T-shirts distributed in schools
- County wide theme, schools plan their own ideas
 Drug Take Back Day
 - Various drop locations across county
 - Encourages people to safely dispose of prescription drugs to prevent abuse
