Analysis Amendment #A03427 to Senate Bill 23, P.N. 682

Amendment Sponsor: L. Baker

- Amends the definition of “perpetrator” by:
 - Only the following may be considered perpetrators for acts of commission:
 - A parent of the child
 - A spouse or former spouse of the child’s parent
 - A paramour or former paramour of the child’s parent.
 - A person 14 years of age or older and responsible for the child’s welfare
 - An individual who is 14 years of age or older who resides in the same home as the child
 - An individual 18 years of age or older who does not reside in the same home as the child but is related within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity by birth or adoption to the child or the spouse, former spouse, paramour or former paramour of the child’s parent
 - Only the following may be considered perpetrators for acts of omission:
 - A parent of the child
 - A spouse of former spouse of the child’s parent
 - A paramour or former paramour of the child’s parent.
 - A person 18 years of age or older and responsible for the child’s welfare
 - A person 18 years of age or older who resides in the same home as the child
- Effective date:
 - Changes the effective date to January 1, 2014
