As you know, I recently met with Pike County Commissioner Harry Forbes, Lehman Township Supervisors John Sivick and Paul Menditto, and representatives of Saw Creek Estates Community Association regarding the proposed Susquehanna-Roseland Transmission Line. I appreciated your participation by phone, as well as the professional insights you were able to provide as a result of your previous experience with similar projects.

After our meeting we toured the area, and it appears that many homes within the development may be impacted. The community is compiling a detailed list of questions regarding the health and environmental effects of the transmission line, as well as the potential public benefits of the proposed project.

I would like to formally request that the Office of Consumer Advocate assists residents in addressing these concerns, and provides information and guidance during the upcoming evaluation process of the formal application submitted by PPL Electric Utilities.
