Bill Summary

Senate Bill 1013, Printer's No. 1202 amends Part II (Gaming) of Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes in section 1407 by further providing for Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund. Specifically, in subsection 1407 (d.1) it strikes provisions related to money deposited into a restricted receipts account established in the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA) for applications submitted by the redevelopment authority of a county of the second class (Allegheny Co.) and instead makes such available for applications submitted by the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA).

This act shall take effect immediately.

Amendment Summary [A02322] (Ward)

This is a technical amendment that would change the effective date from immediately to within 90 days.

Existing Law

Part II (Gaming), Title 4 (Amusements) of Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, known as the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act (Gaming Act) that authorizes slot machine and table games gaming in Pennsylvania. [4 Pa.C.S. § 1101 et seq.]

- Section 1407 provides for establishment of Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund. [4 Pa.C.S. § 1407]
