Team Pennsylvania Foundation is a private non-profit created in 1997 as a mission-driven partnership between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and a diverse group of private sector CEOs. Team PA works to advance economic prosperity for Pennsylvanians through two primary channels of investment: accelerating high-value business growth and increasing access to high-quality education and training.

In Matt's role, he is a key facilitator of many prominent statewide public and private initiatives in the areas of economic development, workforce development, and education.

Since assuming his role in early 2011, Matt has more than tripled the size of the Foundation's endowment (now in excess of \$5MM), grown the Foundation's assets significantly each year, substantially diversified its revenue base through securing more than 75 new funders and strategic partnerships, significantly increased the profile of the Foundation, and helped guide the Foundation's board to develop and enact sweeping improvements to its organizational governance and strategic direction.

Prior to his current position with the Foundation, Matt held various positions within Team PA including Chief Operating Officer and Director of Programming beginning in 2005. Prior to Team PA, he worked with the Capital Region Economic Development Corporation (CREDC) in Central PA. Matt's responsibilities with CREDC included regional economic development tasks that fell outside of direct business finance including workforce development, minority and international business development, corporate site selection, and infrastructure development.

Matt is a member of the Pennsylvania Department of Education Strategic Leadership Advisory Council, board member of the Pennsylvania Economic Development Association, Communities in Schools of Pennsylvania, and the Selection Committee of the Greenlight Fund an internationally recognized leader in scalable impact through targeted philanthropy. Matt has also served on and provided direct facilitation for numerous prominent economic and educational improvement initiatives including as a member of the White House Business Council, Pennsylvania leader for the National Governor's Association Advanced Manufacturing State Policy Initiative, a member of Pennsylvania's Lifesciences Advisory Council, and a direct facilitator of Pennsylvania's Educator Effectiveness Steering Committee, 2012 Governor's Manufacturing Advisory Council, Postsecondary Education Reform Commission, Pennsylvania International Business Advisory Board, and the Governor's Office of Innovation.
