


There have been 2087 voluntary requests from individuals for placement on the PGCB Self-Exclusion List.






Gender Breakdown By Month







* Self-exclusions do not expire. Individuals who have requested 1 or 5 years may, at the conclusion of the period selected, request to be removed from the self-exclusion list.

Race






PA Self-Exclusions By State of Residence



More PA Self-Exclusion Statistics

- Self-excluded individuals who reported to have sought treatment: 35% or 639 individuals*
- Self-excluded individuals who reported to be SE in other jurisdictions: 10% or 181 individuals*
- Self-excluded individuals who reported to have gambled in PA facilities prior to self-exclusion: 85% or 1573 individuals*
- Age range of self-excluded individuals: 21-89 years**
- 1765 individuals voluntarily provided responses. Percentage is based on the number of respondents.

272 known violations of the terms of self-exclusion.

Violations

- Most individuals who have violated the PA Self-Exclusion Program have been identified visually by a PGCB Casino Compliance Representative or a facility employee (security, surveillance and players services).
- Other self-exclusion violators have been identified when the self-excluded individual attempted a transaction that requires proof of identification (obtaining a player club card, receiving a jackpot, cashing a check or simply being "carded").


Removals

• There have been 261 requests for removal, as of February 1, 2011.

 Forty-eight individuals who had removed themselves from the Self-Exclusion List have voluntarily requested to be placed back on the List.

Self-Exclusion Data: By State


