

The SAT[®] Suite of Assessments



Who Uses the SAT Suite of Assessments?

- The College Board currently partners with 13 states (*Michigan, Colorado, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Maine, Delaware, Connecticut, New Hampshire, Alaska, Arkansas, and Oregon*) to administer assessments state-wide
 - including 8 state-wide administrations (Michigan, Illinois, Colorado, Connecticut, Idaho, Delaware, Rhode Island, and New Hampshire) of the SAT School Day in the 2016-17 school year.
 - Additional states (Oklahoma, Tennessee, and Minnesota) have passed legislation to allow districts to choose SAT as their high school assessment
- The College Board also partners with hundreds of school districts in the administration of large-scale assessments.
- Research shows that when Maine replaced its high school statewide assessment with the SAT it increased 4-year college-going rates by 2-3 percentage points overall.

How is the SAT Suite of Assessments used as a state-wide assessment?

- States, districts, and schools receive detailed data reports including all scores and item level performance for each student allowing for the state to use the data in a variety of accountability systems
- Bulk registration ensures Student ID is included in all data reports
- Four school day administrations give schools the flexibility to schedule primary and makeup dates
- Students still receive the benefits of fee-waiver programs for future exams, college applications, and scholarship qualifications
- Accommodations process allows for college reportable scores based on supports approved at the school
- Flexible contract options (by enrollment or test volume) to minimize cost of testing all students or allowing for district choice






Empowering Educators with Better Information: Instructional Planning




Longitudinal Progress Monitoring



Camden schools made national headlines in 2013 for having only three students hit the SAT score that predicts success in college. Now the New Jersey district is celebrating because for the first time in more than a decade, one of its seniors is heading to the Ivy League.

Joshua Sims was dismayed by his junior year PSAT score of 1020 out of 1600, so he studied free Khan Academy videos for math and reading comprehension, puzzled over practice tests and took the SAT three times. In November he racked up 1320—the top score in the district.



The percentage of the SAT test-taking population subgroup that linked their College Board & Khan Academy® accounts.






