4 "adjudication)"

5 , if the court has entered a finding that a child who is

7 Amend Bill, page 3, line 21, by striking out "and" and  
8 inserting a comma

9 Amend Bill, page 3, line 22, by striking out the period after  
10 "abuse" and inserting  
11 , and the terms and conditions thereof include an  
12 acknowledgment, admission or finding that a child who is the  
13 subject of the report has been abused by the child who is  
14 alleged to be delinquent.

15 Amend Bill, page 4, line 4, by striking out all of said line  
16 and inserting

17 ["Founded report for school employee." A report under  
18 Subchapter C.1 (relating to students in public and private  
19 schools) if there has been any judicial adjudication based on a  
20 finding that the victim has suffered serious bodily injury or  
21 sexual abuse or exploitation, including the entry of a plea of  
22 guilty or nolo contendere or a finding of guilt to a criminal  
23 charge involving the same factual circumstances involved in the  
24 allegations of the report.]

3 (3) A report may be indicated by a county agency under  
4 paragraph (1) only upon the approval of the county agency  
5 administrator, or designee, and a county agency solicitor.

6 Amend Bill, page 5, lines 22 through 30; page 6, lines 1  
7 through 15, by striking out all of said lines on said pages and  
8 inserting

9 "School." A facility providing elementary, secondary or  
10 postsecondary educational services. The term includes the  
11 following:

12 (1) Any school of a school district.

13 (2) An area vocational-technical school.

14 (3) A joint school.

15 (4) An intermediate unit.

16 (5) A charter school or regional charter school.

17 (6) A cyber charter school.

18 (7) A private school licensed under the act of January  
19 28, 1988 (P.L.24, No.11), known as the Private Academic  
20 Schools Act.

21 (8) A private school accredited by an accrediting  
22 association approved by the State Board of Education.

23 (9) A nonpublic school.

24 (10) A community college which is an institution now or  
25 hereafter created pursuant to Article XIX-A of the act of  
26 March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School  
27 Code of 1949, or the former act of August 24, 1963 (P.L.1132,  
28 No.484), known as the Community College Act of 1963.

29 (11) An independent institution of higher education  
30 which is an institution of higher education which is operated  
31 not for profit, located in and incorporated or chartered by  
32 the Commonwealth, entitled to confer degrees as set forth in  
33 24 Pa.C.S. § 6505 (relating to power to confer degrees) and  
34 entitled to apply to itself the designation "college" or  
35 "university" as provided for by standards and qualifications  
36 prescribed by the State Board of Education pursuant to 24  
37 Pa.C.S. Ch. 65 (relating to private colleges, universities  
38 and seminaries).

39 (12) A State-owned university.

40 (13) A State-related university.

41 (14) A private school licensed under the act of December  
42 15, 1986 (P.L.1585, No.174), known as the Private Licensed  
43 Schools Act.

44 (15) Hiram G. Andrews Center.
