BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 1113, Printer's No. 1408
Prime Sponsor: Senator Dinniman

SYNOPSIS:

Senate Bill 1113 amends the Public School Code to require comprehensive financial reporting by the State Board of Education during the regulation process.

BILL ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 1113 amends the Public School Code to require the State Board of Education to submit to the Chairmen of the House and Senate Education Committees a detailed fiscal impact statement with every regulation, including those pertaining to keystone exams, during the proposed and final-form stage of the regulatory review process. The detailed fiscal impact statement must explain the financial impact the proposed or final-form regulation will have on the Commonwealth, the communities, the school districts and, if applicable, private and private religious schools. The detailed fiscal impact statement shall include a comprehensive fiscal note of all direct and indirect costs whether incurred in preparation of the proposed or final-form regulation or which will be required as a result of the promulgation of the regulation to its best dollar estimate.

Effective date: 60 days

Amendment #A04021 to SB 1113:

Amendment #A04021 requires the State Board of Education to submit the fiscal note, as prepared by the Office of the Budget, for regulations that pertain to subjects other than the keystone exams.
