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BILL SUMMARY Senate Bill 1211, Printer's No. 1524 Prime Sponsor: M.J. White

A. **SYNOPSIS**:

Senate Bill 1211 would amend the Pennsylvania Public School Code (School Code) to allow the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education (PASSHE) to undertake capital projects funded by Commonwealth general obligation bonds, by capital appropriations or under Article XVI-B of the Fiscal Code ("Borrowing for Capital Facilities") if PASSHE provides the Department of General Services (DGS) with written notice.

B. BILL ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 1211 would amend section 2003-A.1 of the School Code, which gives PASSHE authority to execute and administer construction, repair, renovation and maintenance projects. First, the bill would remove a provision in subsection (a) prohibiting PASSHE from undertaking capital projects that are funded by Commonwealth general obligation bonds or capital appropriations or pursuant to Article XVI-B of the Fiscal Code, unless DGS delegates responsibility for undertaking such a project to PASSHE.

Second, the bill would add a new subsection (a.1) to section 2003-A.1, which would specifically allow PASSHE to undertake projects that are funded by Commonwealth general obligation bonds or capital appropriations or pursuant to Article XVI-B of the Fiscal Code, if PASSHE provides DGS with written notice of its management of the project.

Finally, the bill would amend subsection (d) to section 2003-A.1, which currently provides that PASSHE <u>shall not</u> exercise the power to execute and administer construction, repair, renovation and maintenance projects unless prior written notice setting forth the nature, scope, extent and description of such project has been given to DGS, to provide instead that PASSHE <u>may</u> exercise such power <u>if</u> prior written notice has been given to DGS.

The bill would take effect immediately upon enactment.

C. SUMMARY OF RELEVANT EXISTING LAW:

Under current law, PASSHE may not undertake capital projects that are funded by Commonwealth general obligation bonds or capital appropriations or pursuant to Article XVI-B of the Fiscal Code unless DGS delegates this authority to PASSHE. Further, PASSHE may not execute and administer any construction, repair, renovation and maintenance projects unless prior written notice setting forth the nature, scope, extent and description of the project has been given to PASSHE.

AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain

- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 2003-A.1(a) and (d) of the act of March
- 10 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of
- 11 1949, amended July 11, 1990 (P.L.424, No.103), are amended and
- 12 the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 13 Section 2003-A.1. Project Contracts.--(a) The State System
- 14 of Higher Education is hereby authorized to execute and
- 15 administer contracts for construction, repair, renovation and
- 16 maintenance projects within the meaning of section 2401.1 of the
- 17 act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The
- 18 Administrative Code of 1929," including all aspects of project
- 19 management, design and construction and legal and administrative

- 1 services related to and necessary for the completion of such
- 2 projects[, except capital projects which are funded by
- 3 Commonwealth general obligation bonds, capital appropriations or
- 4 pursuant to Article XVI-B of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343,
- 5 No.176), known as "The Fiscal Code," unless delegated by the
- 6 Department of General Services to the system].
- 7 (a.1) Capital projects which are funded by Commonwealth
- 8 general obligation bonds, capital appropriation or pursuant to
- 9 Article XVI-B of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176),
- 10 known as "The Fiscal Code," may be undertaken pursuant to
- 11 <u>subsection</u> (a) where the system provides the Department of
- 12 General Services with written notice to manage such a project;
- 13 <u>otherwise</u>, responsibility for such a project shall remain with
- 14 the Department of General Services.
- 15 * * *
- 16 (d) The power and authority granted by this section [shall
- 17 not] <u>may</u> be exercised by the system, the board or an institution
- 18 for a project to modify, repair or renovate any facility erected
- 19 by the Department of General Services [unless] when prior
- 20 written notice setting forth the nature, scope, extent and
- 21 description of such project has been given to the Department of
- 22 General Services.

- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
