AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for suspension of reporting.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 118. Suspension of Reporting.--(a) Except as provided for in subsection (b), all reporting required under this act and any regulations promulgated under this act by school districts to the Pennsylvania Department of Education shall be suspended for those school years where the appropriation for Commonwealth funding for basic education funding results in a reduction from the previous fiscal year's State appropriation for basic education funding.

(b) School districts shall continue to provide the following

reports or information:

(1) Annual financial report.

(2) Annual budget information.

(3) Information necessary to determine payments to school districts as set forth in Article XXV of this act.

(4) Reports and information required under Federal law and as required for receipt of Federal funds.

(5) Information required under the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the "Taxpayer Relief Act."

(6) Information required as set forth in Article XIII-A of this act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, or immediately, whichever is later.
