BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 1460, Printer's No. 1892
Prime Sponsor: Representative Gillen

SYNOPSIS:

House Bill 1460 amends Title 51 (Military Affairs) to provide for transcripts.

BILL ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1460 amends Title 51 (Military Affairs) to require an educational institution to give a military member or the member's spouse an "M" on their graded transcript for all classes they were unable to complete due to a military leave of absence.

Effective Date: 60 days.

AMENDMENT A05832 TO HB 1460:

Amendment A05832 would allow an educational institution to place either an "M" or the word "Military" on the graded transcript.
