AN ACT

Amending the act of May 31, 1945 (P.L.1198, No.418), entitled, as amended, "An Act providing for the conservation and 2 3 improvement of land affected in connection with surface 4 mining; regulating such mining; providing for the 5 establishment of an Emergency Bond Fund for anthracite deep mine operators; and providing penalties," establishing the 6 7 Aggregate Advisory Board. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 18 of the act of May 31, 1945 (P.L.1198, 11 No.418), known as the Surface Mining Conservation and 12 Reclamation Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read: Section 18. Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation 13 Fund; Remining Environmental Enhancement Fund; Remining 14 15 Financial Assurance Fund; Department Authority for Awarding of Grants.--* * * 16 (q.1) There is hereby created an Aggregate Advisory Board to 17 18 assist the secretary to expend the funds for the purposes 19 provided by this act and to advise the secretary on all matters

pertaining to mining which shall include, but not be limited to

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- 1 <u>experimental practices</u>, <u>alternate methods of backfilling</u>,
- 2 obligations for preexisting pollution liability, alteration of
- 3 reclamation plans, reclamation fees and bonding rates and
- 4 methods. The board shall function as follows:
- 5 (1) The board shall be comprised of three (3) aggregate
- 6 <u>mining operators; four (4) public members from the Citizens</u>
- Advisory Council, who shall be appointed by the council; one
- 8 (1) member from the County Conservation Districts, who shall
- 9 be appointed by the State Conservation District Commission;
- four (4) members of the General Assembly, two (2) from the
- 11 <u>Senate, one (1) member from the majority party and one (1)</u>
- member from the minority party, who shall be appointed by the
- President pro tempore, and two (2) from the House of
- Representatives, one (1) from the majority party and one (1)
- from the minority party, who shall be appointed by the
- 16 Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- 17 (2) The secretary shall chair the Aggregate Advisory
- 18 Board and appoint the members from the aggregate industry.
- 19 (3) All members shall be appointed for a term of two (2)
- 20 years, except that one-half of the initial members shall
- 21 serve for three (3) years.
- 22 (4) All actions of the board shall be by majority vote.
- 23 The board shall meet upon the call of the secretary, but not
- less than quarterly, to carry out its duties under this act.
- The board shall select from among its members a chairperson
- and such other officers as it deems appropriate.
- 27 <u>(5) The board shall prepare and annual report on its</u>
- activities and submit the report to the Senate Environmental
- 29 Resources and Energy Committee and the House Conservation
- 30 Committee.

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- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
