

invite you to visit and utilize the 12th Senatorial district office in Willow Grove, where you will find information on a myriad I of state programs and departments. Have you ever needed a birth certificate and didn't know where to obtain the form? Well, my office can provide the form and send it to Harrisburg for you, cutting the normal processing time from four to two weeks. Is your license up for renewal and you misplaced the application? My office carries all PENNDOT forms, including registration and handicapped plate and placard forms.

Not only can we be of help with day-to-day matters like drivers licenses – we can assist in critical problems such as the collection of child support and unemployment compensation. The legislative assistants in the office will go to bat for you with all state agencies.

Many senior citizens are not aware of all the benefits available to them in Pennsylvania, especially through programs like Property Tax / Rent Rebate and PACE / PACENET prescription assistance. My office carries the forms for these programs and will help you fill them out and mail them to Harrisburg. I urge you to investigate the possibilities by calling, writing, faxing, or stopping by. The staff members of the district and Capitol offices stand ready to provide assistance to you on state matters, to answer questions, and to receive constituent input on state issues.

The Willow Grove office is open weekdays (except bolidays) between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Leave a message with your name and number if you are calling after hours and we will get back to you promptly.
