

SENATE OF PENNSYLVANIA BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 751 Printer's No. 771

Prime Sponsor: Senator Greenleaf

Committee: Judiciary

SYNOPSIS:

This bill amends Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) to prohibit the sale of electronic cigarettes to minors.

SUMMARY:

This bill amends the definition of "tobacco product" in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6305 (pertaining to the sale of tobacco products to minors) to include "[a]ny electronic device that delivers nicotine or other substance to the person inhaling from the device, including, but not limited to, an electronic cigarette, a cigar, pipe and hookah."

Effective Date: This bill is effective on sixty days.

There is no bill history during this legislative session.
