11	Section 1. Section 2 of the act of May 11, 1972 (P.L.286,

Regulations, Insignia of Certification Required. --* * * 6 7 The department [is authorized to enter into a multistate (j) 8 agreement for the purpose of regulating] shall adopt regulations_ to administer a certification program as described in this 9 section to regulate the construction, installation standards and 10 inspection of industrialized/commercial modular buildings 11 12 shipped from the factory and industrialized/commercial building 13 modules shipped from the factory. [The department shall adopt 14 regulations to administer the program.] Modules of 15 industrialized/commercial modular buildings that are certified 16 under the program established pursuant to this subsection shall be deemed to meet the requirements of the act of November 10, 17 18 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the "Pennsylvania Construction 19 Code Act." 20 Section 3. Sections 5(a) and 6 of the act are amended to 21 read: 22 Section 5. Promulgation of Rules and Regulations by the 23 Department.--(a) The department, in consultation with the 24 Industrialized Housing Advisory Commission shall promulgate 25 rules and regulations to interpret and make specific the 26 provisions of this act. Such rules and regulations adopted, 27 amended, repealed and substituted from time to time pursuant to 28 this section shall assure the health, safety and welfare of the 29 people of Pennsylvania by requiring safe and sanitary industrial housing and industrialized/commercial modular buildings and 30

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1 industrialized/commercial building modules and shall include provisions imposing requirements reasonably consistent with 2 3 recognized and accepted model codes. The department shall adopt such other rules and regulations as are necessary to carry out 4 the provisions of this act. Such rules and regulations shall be 5 consistent with the act of [June 4, 1945 (P.L.1388), known as 6 the "Administrative Agency Law."] July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, 7 8 No.240), referred to as the Commonwealth Documents Law. No portion of this act or any code, or rules and regulations 9 10 adopted, amended, repealed or substituted as provided herein, which limits the work to be performed to any type of 11 12 construction contractor, or labor or mechanic classification 13 shall be adopted or enforceable by the department.

Section 6. Recognition of Certification of Other States or 15 16 the Federal Government. -- The department may issue insignia of 17 certification to industrialized housing [or], housing 18 components, industrialized/commercial modular buildings and 19 industrialized/commercial building modules that have been 20 certified by the United States Department of Housing and Urban 21 Development or competent authority within other states if the 22 department finds that such certification is granted on the basis 23 of standards substantially equivalent to the provisions 24 promulgated under section 5 of this act.

25 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
