Since the passage of House Bill 1055, as well as this Committee's consideration of the companion bill, Senate Bill 1069 (Browne), discussions have been on-going with the Administration and affected groups.

The amendment is mostly technical to reconcile the two bills with two exceptions.

Chapter 3, relating to registration of PEO's, is eliminated.

The amendment further specifies that PEO's must supply confidential employee information to the Pennsylvania Workers' Compensation Rating Bureau as required to comply with existing statutory requirements, and that such information is not considered public records under the Right-to-Know Law.
