HOUSE BILL 1455 (Pashinski)

SYNOPSIS:

House Bill 1455 amends Title 75 (Vehicles) by delegating the administration and enforcement of parking ordinances and resolutions to parking authorities in cities of the third class and second class A.

SUMMARY:

The bill amends Title 75 by authorizing cities of the third class and second class A to delegate powers relating to the enforcement of ordinances and fines to the city's parking authority.

Under this bill, a city of the third class or second class A would be authorized to delegate the administration and enforcement of parking ordinances or resolutions that were enacted or adopted by the city. The parking authorities may also enforce the stopping, standing and parking provisions in the Vehicle Code. Additionally, the city's parking authority may enter into an agreement with the city to transfer a portion of the fines, penalties and costs collected by the authority to the city.

The bill was previously amended in the House Urban Affairs Committee to include Scranton, Pennsylvania's only second class A city.

Effective Date: 60 days.
