A. Synopsis:

HB1300 designates the interchange at Exit 32-B of Interstate 70 in Washington County as the Nathan Burnfield Memorial Interchange.

B. Summary:

Nathan Burnfield attained the rank of First Lieutenant with the Canton Volunteer Fire Department in Washington County, and also served as a police officer, CPR instructor, and arson investigator for South Strabane Township.

On November 4, 2008, as he and his colleagues stopped near the Bentleyville Exit on Interstate 70 to remove a truck wheel and tire from the road, he was struck and killed by a truck that could not stop in time. He passed away at 27 years of age.

Nathan Burnfield will be remembered for his devotion to duty to the citizens of South Strabane Township and Canton Township.
