

# WEEKLY SESSION NOTES

## Monday, February 2, 2015

There were no final passage votes taken in the Senate on Monday.

## Tuesday, February 3, 2015

[Senate Bill 301](#) (Greenleaf) would consolidate in Title 2 (Administrative Law and Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes the statutory provisions relating to Commonwealth documents, including the filing of documents for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin and the Pennsylvania Code; the submission of regulations to the Attorney General and Office of Chief Counsel for review for form and legality; and the preparation of fiscal notes for regulatory actions by the Office of the Budget. Provisions related to the Independent Regulatory Review Commission and the regulatory review process would also be consolidated in Title 2. The bill would repeal the underlying acts which are consolidated. **Passed: 48-0.**

[Senate Resolution 17](#) (Teplitz) recognizes February 2015 as “Career and Technical Education Month” in Pennsylvania. **Adopted by Voice Vote.**

## Wednesday, February 4, 2015

[Senate Bill 210](#) (Greenleaf) would amend Section 4503(a) of Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to exempt from jury duty persons 75 years of age or older who request to be excused, Pennsylvania judges and magisterial district judges and federal judges. **Passed: 48-0.**

[Senate Resolution 18](#) (Kitchen) designates the month of February 2015 as “Black History Month” in Pennsylvania. **Adopted by Voice Vote.**

[Senate Resolution 20](#) (Baker) designates the week of February 8 through 14, 2015 as “Cardiac Rehabilitation Week” in Pennsylvania. **Adopted by Voice Vote.**

[Senate Resolution 21](#) (Blake) designates the month of February 2015 as “Turner Syndrome Awareness Month” in Pennsylvania. **Adopted by Voice Vote.**
