

Public Input Hearings Scheduled for Proposed Rate Increase Request by UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division

Docket No. R-2024-3052716

Did you know?

On January 27, 2025, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (UGI Gas) asked the Public Utility Commission (PUC) to increase rates for gas distribution service. If the PUC grants UGI Gas' requested rate increase request as proposed, UGI Gas can collect an additional \$110.4 million per year from its customers. This would mean that most of UGI Gas' customers will be paying more for monthly gas service than they ever have before.

Do you want to be heard? Attend a Public Input Hearing

- The PUC has scheduled five public input hearings in April 2025 to hear testimony from consumers about UGI Gas' proposed rate increases.
- The OCA encourages affected customers to participate in the public input hearings.
- Details about the scheduled Public Input Hearings are shown on the front and back of this page.

How would UGI Gas' rate increase impact you? *If the Company's request is approved as proposed:*

- The residential fixed customer charge, a charge paid no matter how much or little a consumer uses, would increase by \$4.95 from \$15.00 to \$19.95, a 33 % increase.
- The total bill for a residential customer purchasing 73.7 Ccf per month would increase from \$98.62 to \$108.01, a 10.8 % increase. The increase to residential bills on a distribution only basis (meaning that the cost of the natural gas is excluded) would be 23.8%. Your increase will depend on how much natural gas you use.
- UGI Gas proposes to continue its Weather Normalization Adjustment (WNA) tariff rider to normalize weather sensitive usage by customers between October and May. The WNA charges customers between these months when it is warmer than normal, and credits customers when it is colder than normal on a service rendered basis.
