- 6/14 Arrested subject fleeing and eluding police-recovered heroin
- 6/16 Arrested subject passed out in vehicle-shooting heroin
- 6/24 Robbery committed due to heroin
- 6/25 male and female from Wellsboro arrested-heroin
- 6/27 foot chase arrested heroin-previously out on bail!!
- 6/29 110 bags **heroin** recovered off one suspect
- 7/1 Phila resident on parole arrested-heroin
- 7/2 subjects arrested for **PWID heroin** both on parole

The last 8 we arrested were on parole/probation or out on bail. Parole and Probation and even bail programs are **failing**.

- There are people here making money off others addictions, and there is no end in sight. The **system** needs to understand what a heroin dealer really is and deal with a dealer like they should. They are nothing more than bottom feeding terrorists.
- Police departments are taxed with the spin-off crimes these addicts and or dealers commit and the violence that follows. This will cause **you** to be a victim at some point through theft, burglary, robbery and even assault and perhaps murder.
- In two weeks we have taken over **ten** handguns off the streets by persons who are forbidden from possessing them under law. All these cases involve drugs, namely **heroin**.
- The laws that allow the ability to obtain hypodermic needles should be revisited. The lack of control and immediate availability of syringes that used to be controlled is perhaps fueling a worse problem than what it was designed to stem. We have people shooting up in drug stores, bathrooms, parking lots and along roads and Pharmacists I deal with are not happy. These needles are usually immediately discarded by throwing them out a car window for kids to get. To me this is a failure.
