



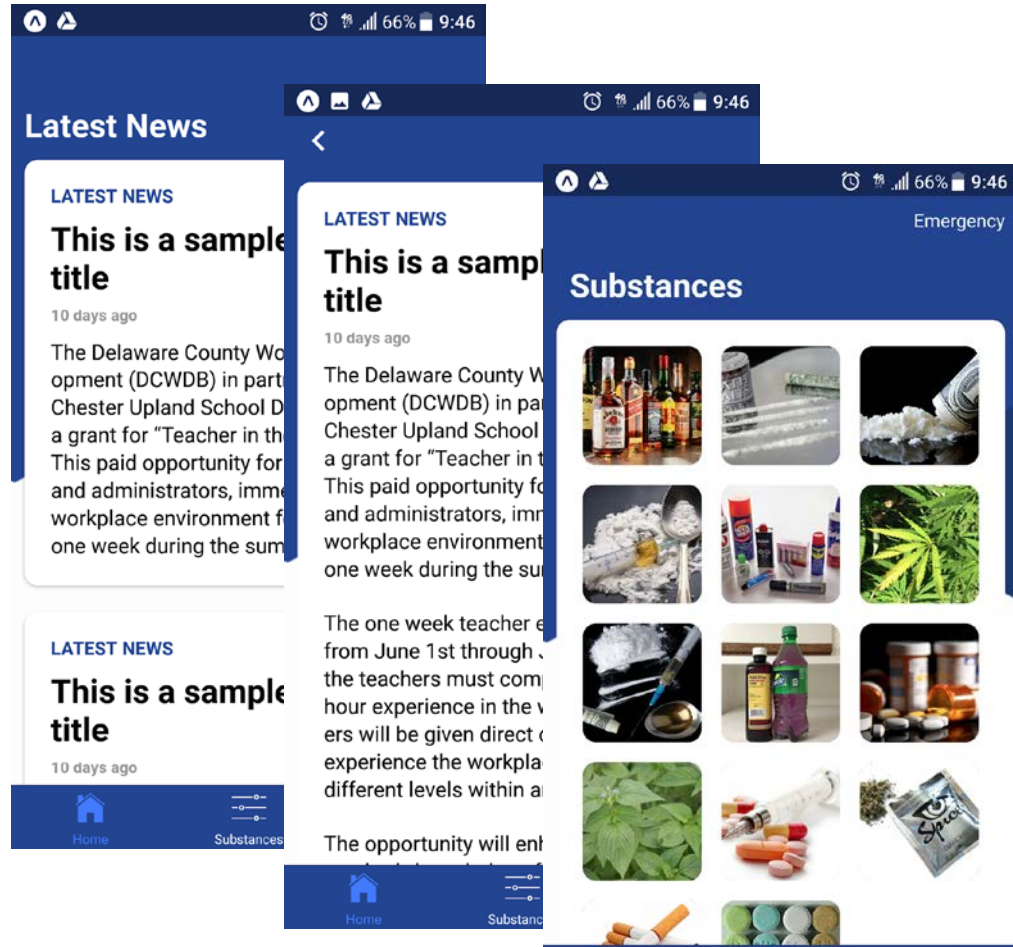

An Android and iOS mobile application where students can follow the latest news released by their school as well as learn about the various dangerous substances and their effects.

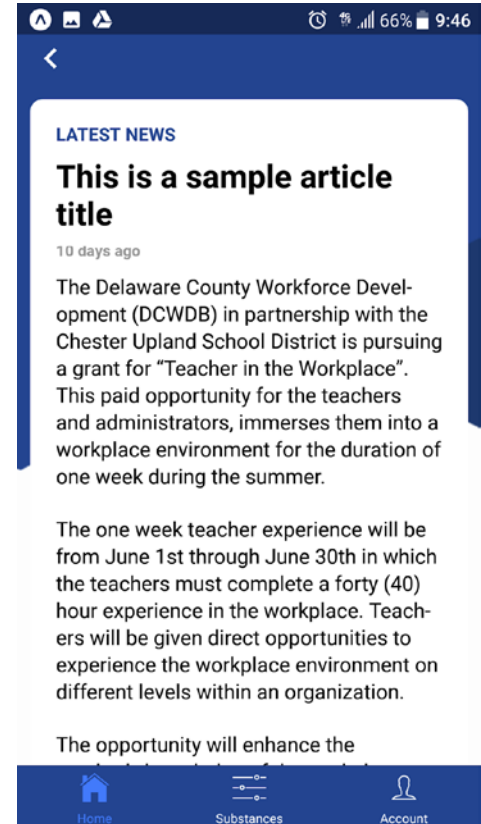
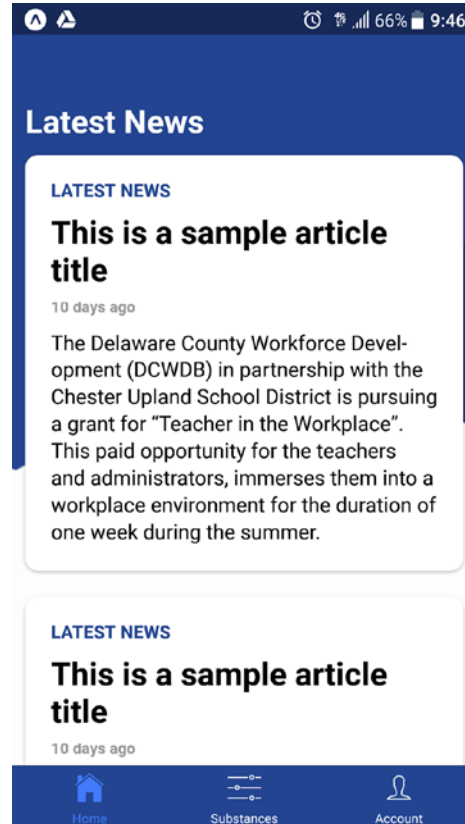

Emergency Beacon

Under the Substance tab you will find an emergency option. The emergency option will allow for a student who is having a medical emergency to send an alert to their emergency contact list with their GPS location. Each member on their contact list will receive a push notification that will open a map showing their position. That contact can then open the location in their phone's native map and get directions.
